

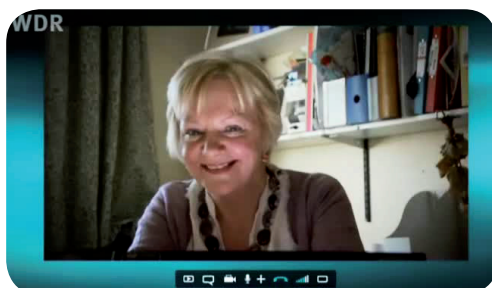


**Writing a dialogue**
